STUDENT ATHLETE COMMITMENT:

1. Practice will be 5 days a week after school from 4:00 to 6:00 pm. There may be some Saturday practice as well.
2. Personal Equipment: Each player is responsible for her equipment, consisting of a girl's lacrosse stick, mouth guard, athletic shoes like soccer shoes with cleats (but no metal cleats), and goggles.
3. Uniform: Each player must purchase and wear in games the official team uniform consisting of a jersey and kilt (cost approximately \$60 based on 2007 prices)
4. Games: Attendance and participation are expected. Attendance is excused on dates when the player is scheduled to take the ACT, SAT or other academic or college entrance exams.
5. Fund Raising: All team members are expected to participate in fundraising activities during the year to support the team and its activities.
6. Academics: All athletes are expected to be in good academic standing.
7. Transportation: Athletes will not be allowed to drive themselves or other athletes to away games. That is the responsibility of the parents/guardians and/or coaches.

PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENT:

1. Financial: A membership fee of \$150 per player (plus uniform charge) is payable to Columbia Girls Lacrosse Club. Players are expected to provide their own equipment. Membership fees are nonrefundable.
2. US Lacrosse Membership is mandatory and dues are \$35/yr. This fee will be paid by the Club with membership in the Columbia Club (and dues paid) by Jan 15. This membership provides a mandatory liability insurance coverage.
3. Participation: The Club depends on parent/guardian participation to function and make possible the existence of the lacrosse team. All parents/guardians are asked to participate in fundraising activities and participate in other work of the Club such as food for parties or concessions (a major fundraiser for the club), telephoning, assistance with paperwork, or any other committee work for the smooth functioning of the Club.
4. Meetings: Parents/guardians are asked to attend club meetings when possible in order to participate in Club decision making and remain aware of the Club efforts. All parents/guardians are welcome to attend not only general meetings but any committee meeting they would like to participate in.
5. Transportation: Each family is expected to provide or arrange transportation for their student athlete to and from games and other team activities in Columbia, St. Louis, and other designated cities. Games are played in Kansas City, St. Louis and Columbia.
